Three years ago, the Board of the Jewish Federation of New Mexico adopted an ambitious strategic plan establishing goals and actions to guide the JFNM forward.

As a “blueprint” to strengthen New Mexico’s Jewish community, the primary goals included:

Identifying and building new leadership in Albuquerque, Santa Fe, Taos and elsewhere; providing a voice for the Jewish community that addresses critical public issues and celebrates Jewish life; and funding and implementing programs that meet the needs of Jews of all ages in New Mexico

Three years later, we have met many of our objectives while deepening partnerships with Jewish organizations and congregations across New Mexico to meet the ever-growing needs of an ever-growing community.

2011, however has proved to be a historic one for the Jewish Federation of New Mexico, as a major bequest from the estate of Albuquerque philanthropists Irving and Hertha Auerbach will bring the JFNM’s 2011 annual campaign above one million dollars – a first in the Federation’s history, and a key goal of the three-year strategic plan.

While most of this bequest will be used to strengthen JFNM reserves, \$41,667 will be endowed to establish the “Irving and Hertha Auerbach Fund for Jewish Identity” at the Jewish Community Endowment Foundation of New Mexico, earmarked for PJ Library, Camp Scholarships and Birthright/Taglit.

This wonderful gift aside, throughout this past year the JFNM Board, led by Campaign chairs Linda Friedman and Sabra Minkus, worked hard to meet the very heart of our mission -- supporting the agencies and programs that depend on an annual JFNM allocation. As of June 13th, our overall 2011 annual campaign has reached \$714,000 excluding the Auerbach bequest.

Thanks to the \$260,048 in allocations provided this year by the JFNM, the following has been realized:

- Jewish Family Service of New Mexico’s Community Chaplaincy program in Albuquerque, Rio Rancho and Santa Fe and intensive social worker program are meeting more client needs than ever;
- The Solomon Schechter Day School is providing more critically needed scholarships to families;
- The Jewish Community Center of Greater Albuquerque is able to continue offering outstanding Jewish programs for youth and seniors, as well as Camp Chai scholarships;
- The New Mexico Jewish Historical Society (which is housed at the Federation office) is successfully maintaining its operations;
- The Rabbis and Cantors Association of Albuquerque is able to offer joint congregational programs;
- Nahalat Shalom is able to offer sign-language interpretation for the hearing impaired at services;

- The JFNM's Youth Conclave Fund offers ongoing scholarships to Jewish teens looking to attend a retreat or conference through their congregation or youth groups;
- The Taos Jewish Center is able to continue an acclaimed education program, and enjoy a Shabbat program with Rabbi Stephen Landau;
- In Santa Fe, Kol BeRamah received support for two scholar-in-residence weekends and HaMakom is proceeding with an Arts and Education Program (HAEP) Club;
- To explore the social services, educational, social and spiritual needs and interests of the Jewish community west of Albuquerque, the Jewish Federation of New Mexico convened a "Town Hall meeting" in Rio Rancho, facilitated by Anita Miller, Chair of the Federation's Jewish Community Relations Council. This gathering led to a series of "Brunch & Learn" programs in Rio Rancho, and the subsequent development of an active planning committee that is building a vibrant Jewish presence in this fast-growing city.

This year also saw the JFNM entering into an administrative partnership with Hillel at the University of New Mexico. Under the guidance of Dr. Sara Koplik, the Federation's Director of Community Outreach, Hillel has experienced a true revival, with students enjoying frequent Shabbat dinners, lectures, classes and services. Two Israeli Counsels General visited the campus, along with representatives of Birthright-Taglit Israel and the Jewish Agency. In January, actress and comedian Rain Pryor performed *Fried Chicken and Latkes* for a Hillel benefit in front of a packed audience.

Statewide, 2011 saw JFNM going deep with our outreach: with JFNM funding, the Las Vegas Jewish Community (LVJC) is receiving ongoing programming/administrative assistance under the guidance of JFNM Leadership program participant Maggid Ya'el Chaikind and to help our rabbi-less communities grow and become stronger, JFNM presented Rabbi Stephen Landau's visits to Congregation B'nai Israel in Roswell and Temple Beth El in Carlsbad in April.

In Israel, the Nitzana Rural Educational Community & Youth Futures Program in the Negev desert is now receiving JFNM support for their science and technology program, and Creativity for Peace has JFNM underwriting for a participant in their extraordinary Israel-Palestine coexistence program.

JFNM also led the statewide Israel Forest Fire Disaster Relief Fund fundraising efforts, raising more than thirteen thousand dollars help those affected by the devastating Carmel Mountain region fires. And thanks to our ongoing partnership with Son Broadcasting/Christians United

for Israel, "Night to Honor Israel" events in Albuquerque and Deming raised funds to benefit Ben Yakir Youth Aliyah Village in Hadera.

To respond to local Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions activities aimed against Israel's right to exist, in 2011 JFNM convened the New Mexico Israel Action Network, chaired by Dr. Todd Goldblum. JFNM has been most visible on this issue, with our advocacy efforts generating attention in venues ranging from *Al Jazeera* and the *Albuquerque Journal*. We've continued to administer New Mexico's Israel advocacy website, nmisrael.org, and throughout this year we've brought to New Mexico speakers Gershom Sizomu, Chief Rabbi of Uganda, Rabbi Brad Hirschfield of the Center for Jewish Learning and Leadership, Jeff Kaye of ORT, Dani Ben-David of the Taub Center and internationally-acclaimed speaker Neil Lazarus, who brought his Israel advocacy training to Albuquerque and Santa Fe in early October.

JFNM provided scholarships to six young Jews through our Israel Experience Fund, and helped underwrite Mayor Richard Berry's trip to Israel last winter to participate in a renewable energy and water sustainability conference.

The introduction this spring of the New Mexico-Israel Business Exchange with Chair Robert Efrogmson and acting director Susan Keith has tremendous potential to broker economic opportunities between Israel and New Mexico. We also entered this year into a new partnership with JerusalemOnlineUniversity.com for three-part Israel advocacy program, as well as a forthcoming community-wide Israel education program for Albuquerque Jewish teens.

For members of our legal community, JFNM presented a full-day CLE program in May with University of Utah Law Professor Amos Guiora, who provided an introduction to International Law, attended by staff members of the US Attorney's office.

Recognizing that Albuquerque lacks a strategy to provide employers with workers who have the skills and preparation for "middle-skill" jobs that will maintain, grow and build new enterprises, JFNM, in partnership with Albuquerque Interfaith, received a grant from the Jewish Council for Public Affairs to engage Jewish involvement in Workforce Development. This will enable individuals to get jobs in specific industries and to advance over time to successively higher levels of education and work in that industry.

To draw attention to the sad fact that New Mexico ranks as the twelfth worst state for household food insecurity, the JFNM and New Mexico Appleseed joined with the JCPA to hold a “Hunger Seder” on April 11th to advocate for a moral budget that helps feed our community through programs such as SNAP (food stamps) and WIC (Women, Infants, and Children).

JFNM has also been working with officials on matters of importance to the Jewish community: Israel’s security, and Jewish agency and synagogue security enhancement.

And the JFNM-published *New Mexico Jewish Link* remains a primary vehicle for keeping community members “in the know”, stimulating dialogue and building connections between Jews from one end of the state to another.

Lastly, the Jewish Community Endowment Foundation of New Mexico, a division of the JFNM led by Chair Erika Rimson and her dedicated Board of Directors, worked to shape the future of our Jewish com-

munity. The JCEF currently holds six endowed funds and five non-endowed funds for a total of approximately \$525, 850 as of 5/31/2011. The JCEF’s Jewish Women’s Fund of New Mexico was “kicked off” in January with a reception featuring Northern Trust VP Grace Allison; to-date, the fund has reached \$40,000 to annually provide small grants to programs that assist local Jewish women and children in need. The JCEF website -- www.jcefnm.org – is also now live.

We do all of this with a small staff – just two full-time employees on a lean administrative budget that our Finance Committee and Board of Directors are responsibly stewarding. We’ve also begun working with Phil Messuri and Financial Network Investment Corporation on protecting and conservatively growing JFNM investments.

With more Jews come more needs, especially in the realm of social services and Jewish education. Ultimately, it’s our generous supporters, listed in this report, who keep the miracle of Jewish New Mexico alive and thriving, for ourselves and the generations to come.

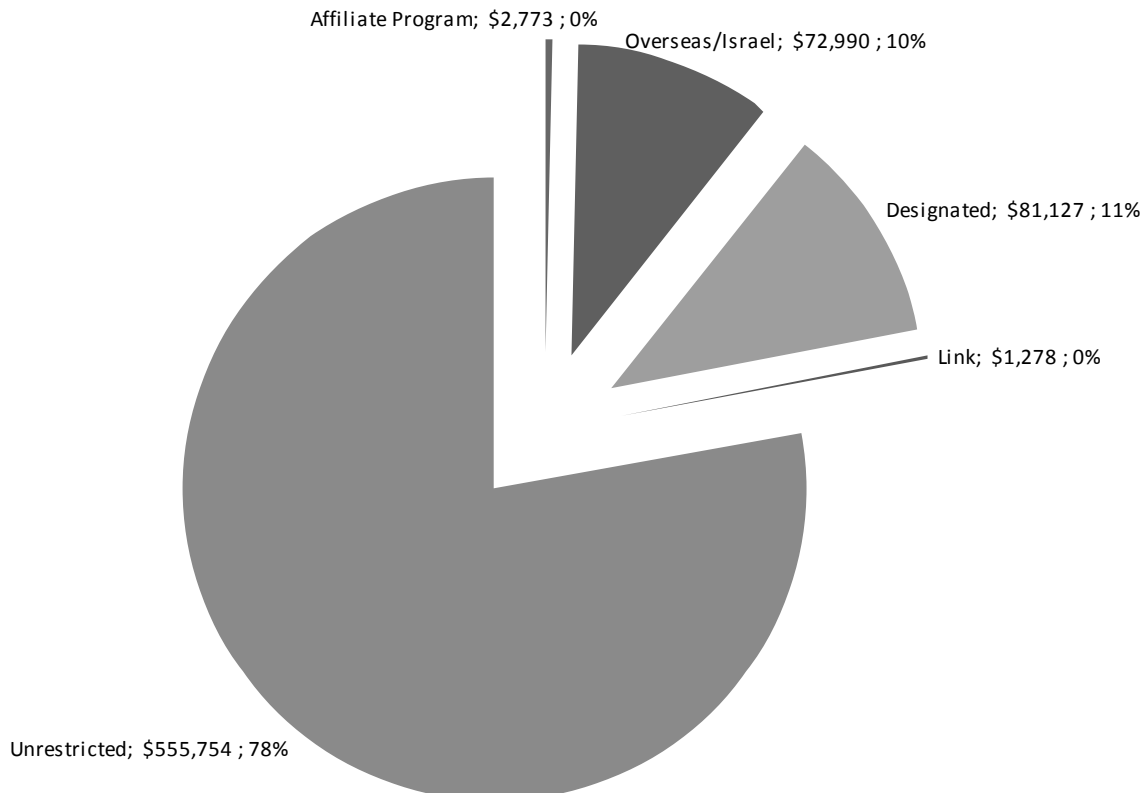
